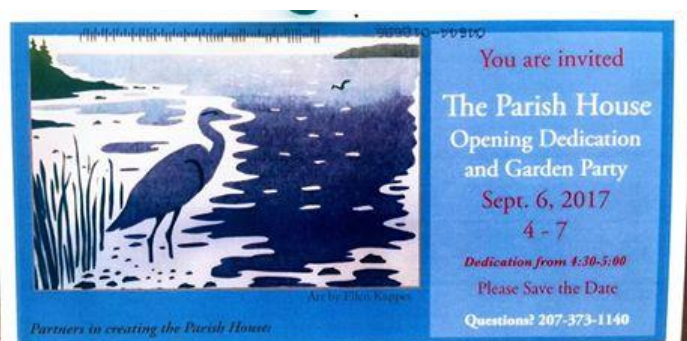
YWCA IS ON A MISSION
